

How many MW of battery energy storage in Argentina?

Argentina's government said on Monday it has awarded contracts for 667 MW of capacity in its first tender dedicated to battery energy storage systems (BESS), exceeding its original 500-MW target by about 30%.

Does Argentina have a battery storage tender?

Argentina has opened a \$500 million battery storage tender aimed at adding 500 MW of new energy storage capacity in the Buenos Aires metropolitan area. The AlmaGBA program, managed by CAMMESA, offers long-term contracts with fixed payments and financial guarantees to attract developers.

How long does it take Buenos Aires to build a storage facility?

These projects will be installed in critical locations in the Buenos Aires metropolitan area, with planned investments exceeding USD 540 million (EUR 461.1m). Operations are expected to begin within 12 to 18 months, the energy secretariat said. The Alma-GBA storage tender saw 15 companies submit 27 projects for 1,347 MW of capacity.

Why is Argentina a good stance on energy storage?

In Argentina, the stance provides a good lesson to the European stakeholders, especially in the commercial and industrial segments of energy storage. Emerging markets can present both local and foreign players by developing tenders that are investment appropriate and clear technically and financially secured.
