

How do I Stop my Pajero from overheating?

Regularly flushing and cleaning the radiator in your Pajero can help prevent this issue. A common trick to help temporarily cool an overheating engine is by turning on the heater on full blast in your Pajero. When you activate the heater, it draws heat away from the engine's cooling system and into the cabin of the car.

Can a blocked radiator cause engine overheating in Pajero?

A blocked radiator can also contribute to engine overheating in Pajero. Over time, debris, dirt, and mineral deposits can accumulate in the radiator, hindering the flow of coolant. This reduced circulation means that the engine can't effectively dissipate heat, leading to overheating.

What temperature should a Pajero engine stay at?

In order to keep its good performance, the engine of your Pajero must always stay within the optimal temperature range, which is usually around 190°F (90°C). To guarantee this temperature, the system has two "auxiliary" pieces that control temperatures: the thermostat and the electric fan.
