5G finally arrived in Bangladesh on Monday after telcos Robi Axiata and Grameenphone reportedly launched 5G services within a few hours of each other, and 18 months after receiving ...

In contrast, Bangladesh is in the early stages of 5G adoption. Teletalk launched limited 5G services in urban pockets in December 2021, but broader coverage is yet to materialise.

Dhaka - Robi Axiata PLC has officially become the first mobile operator in Bangladesh to launch commercial 5G services, marking a historic step in the nation's digital transformation.

Bangladesh started its 5G journey in December 2021 when Teletalk Bangladesh Limited, the state-owned telecom company, launched the first commercial 5G network in the country.

Both Robi and Grameenphone have started 5G services without charging extra, keeping the same prices as 4G. The move is aimed at encouraging more people to use 5G by removing financial barriers.
