

# Havana Uninterruptible Power Supply Production Plant

At least four western provinces, from Pinar del Rio to Mayabeque, lost power early on Wednesday, officials said, though all had been reconnected to the grid within hours of the outage.

The electric grid on the island of Cuba went entirely offline Friday after the failure of a major power plant east of Havana, government officials announced.

The country's power grid collapsed on Friday, Oct. 18, due to the failure of one of the island's largest thermal power plants--the 330-MW Antonio Guiteras thermoelectric plant in Matanzas...

The collapse of Cuba's largest power plant, Antonio Guiteras in the northwestern province of Matanzas, is behind the latest blackout. Set up in 1988, it had been undergoing extensive...

In addition, it has been losing part of its operations, following the withdrawal of the Mariel, Rent&#233;, Nuevitas units and the historic Tallapiedra plant in Havana.

HAVANA - Cuba's national electrical grid shut down on Friday after one of the island's major power plants failed, Cuba's energy ministry said, plunging the entire country into a blackout.

The plant, located in Matanzas and built in 1988 with French technology, is the largest single-unit block in the country, with an installed capacity of 330 megawatts (MW).
