It's important to store breast milk correctly so that it's safe to feed your baby. Here you'll find advice and tips on the best ways to store breast milk. Breast milk can be stored in a sterilised container, or special storage bags- remember to label and date it. Store it in small quantities to avoid wasting any. Your breast milk can then be kept:

Can you store breast milk in a freezer bag?

If you pick breast milk freezer bags for storage, some tips to ensure safety include: Use a double bag if you're using a thinner storage bag. Place all storage bags that contain breast milk inside a hard plastic storage container with a lid within the freezer. Never using ordinary plastic storage bags or bottle liners to store your breast milk.

How long can you keep expressed breast milk?

How long you can safely keep expressed breast milk depends on how you store it. Keep in mind these general guidelines: Room temperature. You can keep freshly expressed breast milk at room temperature for up to six hours. But it's best to use or store the breast milk within four hours, especially if the room is warm. Insulated cooler.

Where should milk be stored?

Plan on when the milk will be used, and store milk either in the back of the freezer or upper shelf of the refrigerator, but not the door. The duration of milk storage varies at different temperatures:
