The Nigerien military controls the base, but was built and paid for by the United States. The US Army used the base for drone operation during the American Intervention of Niger. As of Janu...

Airmen stationed at Nigerien Air Base 101 in Niamey, Niger, and Air Base 201 in Agadez, support partner forces and international efforts to counter violent extremist organizations in the region.

The U.S. military operates two drone bases in Niger: One, dubbed Air Base 101, out of Niger's capital of Niamey and the other, Air Base 201, near Agadez that cost \$110 million to build.

Niger (Air Base 101, Niamey, and Air Base 201, Agadez): Both these airbases are located in the West African country of Niger. Both bases are operated by the U.S. military as drone ...

The U.S.-constructed air base in Agadez, Niger, is now fully operational, carrying out its first unmanned intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance flights in October 2019.

At one time, roughly 1,000 U.S. troops were in Niger working at the base in Agadez and another drone installation in the nearby capital city of Niamey.

Before a coup in Niger in July 2023 led to the demand that American troops leave the country, the U.S. used two Niger airbases to fly drones on counterterrorism missions in the Sahel ...
