How much do solar panels cost?

As of 2026, the average cost of residential solar panels in the U.S. is between \$15,000 and \$25,000 before incentives. This typically translates to about \$2.50 to \$3.50 per watt of installed capacity (more on price per watt below). The total price depends on your system size, location, roof type, and installer.

How much does a 7 kW solar system cost?

These costs are for a typical 7 kW residential system (\$19,873 average). Monocrystalline or polycrystalline panels are the most common types of solar panels. Most residential installations use monocrystalline photovoltaics (PV) panels, which offer up to 24% efficiency and perform better in limited space and extreme temperatures.

How much does solar cost per watt?

The price per watt for larger and relatively straightforward projects are often within the \$2.50 to \$3 range. Claiming incentives like tax credits and rebates can bring the PPW even lower. However, the following factors may push your solar price per watt into the \$3 to \$4.50 range.

How much does a 5 kilowatt solar system cost?

The average national cost for a 5-kilowatt system ranges from \$14,000 to \$20,900, depending on the source and period of data. EnergySage reports that the average cost of a 10.8 kW solar panel installation is around \$29,926 before federal tax credits, which reduces to \$20,948 after the credits are applied.
