Inside, there are 12 battery clusters arranged back-to-back, each with an access door for equipment entry, installation, debugging, and maintenance. Each battery cluster contains eight battery packs ...

The circulating water pump sends the coolant to the plate heat exchanger for heat exchange with the refrigerant, and sends the cooled coolant to the container to cool the battery pack.

After securing the container, it is recommended that the side and end doors of the container be locked by padlock (as shown in the figure below) to prevent unauthorized access.
