

# What is the music of solar power generation

"Solar Power" reflects Lorde pulling from Earth not just lyrically, but musically too. Where "Pure Heroine" and "Melodrama" were filled with euphoric synths and crisp digital sounds, this album ...

Classified by Lorde as her "weed album", Solar Power is a psychedelic pop and indie folk effort built around acoustic guitar arrangements, marking a departure from the electronic-based music of her ...
